The key to effective forward analysis lies not in claiming false precision about future outcomes but in identifying the variables that will matter most and the signposts that will signal which path is being taken. For conclusions and strategic

recommendations, the analytical framework established in this report provides a structured approach to incorporating new information as it becomes available in 2026 and beyond.
